FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT FORMAT (CATS)

CAT 1: Personal Assignment > **10 Marks**

CAT 2: Group Assignment > **10 Marks**

CAT 3: Project or Term paper following the University's Format > **20 Marks**

ALL CATS SHALL BE SUBMITTED BEFORE OR ON THE DAY OF EXAMINATION.

SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT FORMAT (END OF SEMESTER EXAM)

1. The examination shall consist of **3 Sections ; A,B and C**
2. The students shall attempt 10-20 objectives Questions in section A carrying a total of ten **(10) marks**. The questions will be testing knowledge in Level 1 and 2 of Blooms Taxonomy.
3. Section B will comprise of 3 compulsory brief structured questions each with at least two parts. The questions will be testing knowledge in level 3 and 4 of Blooms' Taxonomy. Each Question shall be worth ten (10) Marks making a total of thirty **(30) marks**.
4. Section C will comprise of at least five optimal (5) questions. The questions will be testing knowledge in level 5 and 6 of Blooms' Taxonomy. The candidate will be expected to attempt 3 questions each carrying twenty (20) marks. Making a total of sixty **(60) marks**

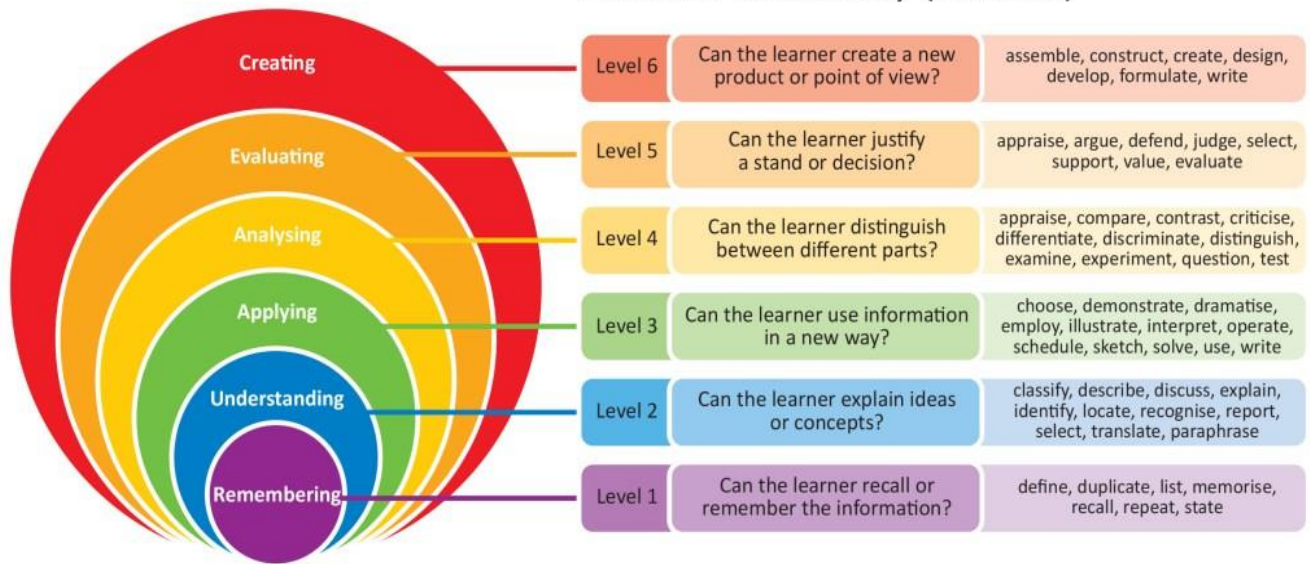
