KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER

All tests (CATs and Finals) must be aligned to **Student Learning Outcomes (SLOs)** as written in the Course Syllabus
Graded CAT Papers should have **constructive feedback** beyond the grade/marks
Final exams should have a simple matrix indicating how the questions relate to the SLOs
Preferably CAT 3 and Final Exam's Section B Essays in the Final Exam should have **Rubrics** for grading them
For Final Exams, submit, **Exam A and B, Course Syllabus, and Marking Keys for Exam A and B**
Exam A is for the **End of Semester Exam** while **Exam B** is for taken as a **Supplementary/Special Exam**
Final Exam Marking Key constitutes **Section A's answers** and **Section B's Rubrics**
At the start of the Semester, inform the students the **grading criteria** for CATs and Final Exams (Section A and B)
All lecturers are required to attend moderations as per the Academic Calendar
